Kampus Merdeka **Curriculum**

President University offers a curriculum that focuses on building students' portfolios and practical experiences throughout their academic journey. Here is an overview of the Year 1-3 programs:

YEAR 1

- Internship Experience Program or Startup Building Program (Semesters 1-2): Students have the opportunity to participate in an internship or startup building program to gain practical experience in their chosen field.

How to Join President University?

Admission and Application Requirements

All freshmen applicants - both international and Indonesian candidates - must complete the Application form along with the required documents.

You will need to submit:

- A copy of KTP or student ID card or for international student are the certified copy of pages of your passport stating your full names, date and place of birth and expiration date of the passport
- A certified copy of your original academic diploma in the original language
- A certified translation of your original academic diploma in the original language (for international students)
- A certified copy of your transcript (list of grades/marks) in the original language
- A certified translation of your final transcript (list of grades/marks) in English.

Explanation of "certified copies"

Certified copies are either copies which bear the original logo or stamp of (1) the institute (the school) which issued the original document (2) an Indonesia Embassy or consulate, (3) translations which bear the stamp of the sworn translator who translated the original document.



Required English Standardized Test

A strong knowledge of English is essential for successful study at President University, including the ability to understand and express thoughts quickly and clearly. We require standardized English test scores at minimum of 400 from TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) at the freshman first year.

Although you are not required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) of other proficiency exams, you may submit your scores if you have done so.
